Send to all vineyard managers in county

1. PROBLEM
 - a. Do you believe there is a red leaf disease problem in California vineyard industry? In the Monterey County vineyard industry?
 - b. How concerned are you?
 - c. Are you aware of a problem in the area you farm?
2. STAFF KNOWLEDGE
 - a. Can you and your staff identify vines expressing leafroll symptoms?
 - b. Can you and your staff identify leafroll vectors?
 - i. Mealybugs male and female?
 - ii. Scale
 - iii. Others?
 - c. Do you understand research backed containment and control solutions?
 - d. Do you/your staff need education/best practices?
3. PEST MANAGEMENT PLAN
 - a. Do you have a plan in place for managing leafroll virus vectors?
4. COLLECTIVELY
 - a. Would it be beneficial to work together as a county?
5. LOCATION
 - a. In what area do you farm? Salinas, Chuala, Gonzales, Soledad, Greenfield....
 - b. In what neighborhood do you farm? (share map in survey)
6. TRAP DATA
 - a. Are you currently trapping?
 - b. Are you willing to share trap data anonymously under large Monterey County location?
